



## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING MAIL ORDER FORM

**SECTION 1 - HUNTER INFORMATION** - Clearly print all information requested.

**SECTION 2 - PURCHASING HUNTING ITEMS** - Proof of hunter education is required at the time of application.

**Acceptable Proof of Hunter Education** - (Submit a copy of one of the following)

- An annual California hunting license issued in any prior year;
- A two-day nonresident California hunting license issued after the 1999/2000 license year;
- A written declaration which states that the applicant had a California hunting license in any prior year, but that license is now lost or destroyed;
- A California certificate of hunter education completion or equivalency with a California hunter education validation stamp;
- A certificate of successful completion of a California-approved hunter education course from any state or province; or
- A current hunting license or a hunting license issued in either of the two previous years from any state or province.

**Select Appropriate Hunting License:**

- **Resident Hunting License** - Required for any person 16 years of age or older who has resided continuously in California for at least six months immediately preceding the date of application; any person on active duty with the United States armed forces; or a Job Corps enrollee.
- **Nonresident Hunting License** - Required for any person 16 years of age or older who has **NOT** resided in California for at least six months immediately preceding the date of application; is **NOT** on active duty with the United States armed forces; and is **NOT** a Job Corps enrollee.
- **Two-day Nonresident Hunting License** - Required for any person 16 years of age or older who has **NOT** resided in California for at least six months immediately preceding the date of application; is **NOT** on active duty with the United States armed forces; and is **NOT** a Job Corps enrollee. **IMPORTANT! This license is NOT valid for deer, bear, antelope, elk, sheep or pig.**
- **Junior Hunting License** - Required for any resident or nonresident less than 16 years of age.
- **Disabled Veteran Hunting License** - Required for any honorably discharged disabled veteran with a 50 percent or greater service-connected disability. Certification from the United States Department of Veterans' Affairs is required at the time of application or a copy of a previous year's California disabled veteran's reduced-fee hunting license.

**SECTION 3 - SELECTING ADDITIONAL ITEMS FROM THE FOLLOWING:** (Requires the purchase of a 2007/2008 California hunting license or the original 2007/2008 hunting license in order to apply for 2007/2008 big game tags.)

- **Deer Tag Applications** - Residents and nonresidents 12 years of age or older at the time of application or who turn 12 before July 1, 2007, may purchase a first-deer tag application and a second-deer tag application. Enter up to three tag choices (See the 2007 Hunting Digest-Big Game for proposed zones and hunts). **Up to six hunters may apply as a party. To be processed as a party, all hunters in the party must:**
  1. Submit their applications in the same envelope or in the same fax transmission, with the party leader's application on top;
  2. Check "I am applying as a party for the premium deer tag drawing", and indicate party leader's name and driver's license, DMV ID or DFG ID number;
  3. Designate the number of hunters in their party and list the same party leader; and
  4. All party members must make same tag choices in the same order on their applications.
- **Bear Tag Applications** - Resident and nonresident hunters 12 years of age or older at the time of application may purchase one bear tag application per license year.

**SECTION 4 - SELECTING ADDITIONAL ITEMS FROM THE FOLLOWING:** (Requires the purchase of a hunting license or a photocopy of your 2007/2008 hunting license must be attached.)

- **Bobcat Tags** - Residents and nonresidents 12 years of age or older at the time of application may purchase one book of five (5) bobcat tags per license year.
- **Wild Pig Tags** - Residents and nonresidents 12 years of age or older at the time of application may purchase multiple pig tags which are sold individually. There is no limit on the number of pig tags you may purchase. Tags are nonrefundable and nontransferable.
- **Upland Game Bird Stamps** - Required by any person taking upland game bird species, **excluding** juniors hunters hunting under the authority of a junior hunting license.
